

10 Equivalent One-Liners

Definitions:

- Symbol/Words = Sensations with meanings. Read, heard, spoken, written, mostly thought
 - Meaning = non trivial difference between presence of words; trivial difference - the one in sight, sound etc.
- Explicit knowledge of xyz = to consciously know = awareness of = experience of = notion of= to explicitly differentiate xyz from everything else
- Sensations = Not the same as sensory. Common factor between waking and dreaming. Evident sight, sound, touch, smell, taste- includes words/symbols. Body-brain-senses called own and space (waking or dreaming) are part of it

Raw (unlabeled) sensations, wordless awareness, is neither of anything, nor to anyone - till words arise to reflect on it

As the presence of symbols + meanings, so the notion of self, time and of reality; no symbols, no knowledge of anything, not even of "is" vs. "is not", just clarity - no questions, no question-er, nor anything to ask questions about

“Words appear” is a word appearance, is awareness of past/time, of a self aware of that time; so is this meta description

Doing is evident, doer is an assumption, a concept, a belief; knowing is evident, know-er is an assumption, a concept, a belief

How do words emerge ? Like question, every answer, justification, accept, reject - also word emergence; so is this one

What can be known about oneself or the world without words? Any response, except silence, would also be words

7

When words are (present), other phenomena are (known); when words are not, other phenomena are not

I don't know anything, not even who this "I" is

Default view says that nothing CAN be known without words/symbols, but without words, symbols, there is nothing TO know, nor anyone TO know!
